We minister to the same body

Prophetic gifts—abilities based on understanding and articulating truth

We minister to the same body

These include “*word of wisdom*” (v. 8), “*word of knowledge*” (v. 8), *prophecy, tongues, and interpretation* (v. 10), *discerning spirits* (v. 10), *teaching* (v. 29)

Other NT—*evangelism* (Eph 4:11), and *speaking* (1 Pet 4:10, 11)



We minister to the same body

Priestly gifts—abilities based on understanding and supplying basic needs

We minister to the same body

These include *healing* and *working miracles* (**vv. 9, 10**), *helping* (**v. 28**)

Other NT—encouragement or *exhortation* (**Rom 12:8**), *pastoring* (**Eph 4:11**), *ministry* or serving (**Rom 12:7**), *giving* or sharing (**Rom 12:8**), *mercy* (**Rom 12:8**)



We minister to the same body

Kingly gifts—abilities based on understanding direction and group needs

We minister to the same body

These include *faith* (v. 9) “the ability to envision a goal clearly” and *administration* (v. 28)

Other NT—include founding gifts
(*apostle/planter*) (**Eph 4:11**), *leadership* (**Rom 12:8**)
